Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This MoU is entered into and executed on this 27th day of January 2022 at Kollam.

BY AND BETWEEN

JYOTI NIVAS COLLEGE Autonomous, Bengaluru, a premier institute for women (hereinafter referred to as "JNC"), through its Principal, having its registered/approved office at Hosur Road, Koramangala, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560 095 which expression shall, where the context so admits, be deemed to include its successors, executors and administrators of the **ONE PART**

AND

FATIMA MATA NATIONAL COLLEGE (Autonomous), Kollam (hereinafter referred to as "FMNC"), a well-known autonomous aided college owned and managed by the Catholic Diocese of Quilon, represented by its Principal, having its office at Kollam-691 001 (which expression, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, shall be deemed to mean and include their executors, administrators and assigns), party of the **SECOND PART.**

WHEREAS JNC affiliated to the Bengaluru City University, offering quality education by conducting versatile undergraduate and postgraduate programmes since 1966, equipping students to achieve greater goals by training them to obtain placements and career progression

WHEREAS FMNC, affiliated to the University of Kerala conducting various Science, Arts and Commerce streams, offering 17 undergraduate, 10 postgraduate and 7 research programmes.

WHEREAS both institutions are of the opinion that mutual cooperation and sharing of resources would be beneficial for the academic and extracurricular growth and development of students of both institutions

WHEREAS both parties have held discussions and therein agreed upon collaboration for enhancing the academic quality of both institutions.

THEREFORE, both parties had an initial discussion for identifying the areas of collaboration and operation methodologies, and arrived at a consensus:

1. Areas of cooperation: -

- a. Student Placement: Arranging Grooming Sessions
- b. Student Empowerment: It involves arranging programmes, viz.
 - i. Student Exchange
 - ii. Placement drives during an open to all drive in either of the institutions
 - iii. Monthly Student Interactive Sessions
 - iv. Capacity Building Programmes, and
 - v. Student Internships
- c. Library Resource Sharing: It involves-
 - i. Sharing Databases and e-resources
 - ii. Providing Books on loan basis (*books which are very rare can be made available for a very limited period. The books can be sent through post or courier*)
 - iii. Initiating Academic Forums
 - iv. Organizing Collaborative Workshops/ Seminars on 'Reference Management', 'Intellectual Property Rights' and 'Academic Writing'

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- d. Faculty Empowerment: It involves programmes like-
- i. Adjunct Faculty
 - ii. Faculty Training on topics like 'Student Mentoring', 'Vocational Schemes' and 'Student Management'
 - iii. FDPs on a collaborative basis
 - iv. Arranging Short-Term Training Sessions
- e. Research: It involves programmes like-
- i. Organizing Summer Schools
 - ii. Providing internship for Postgraduate students
 - iii. Sharing laboratory resources
 - iv. Executing collaborative projects
 - v. Organizing collaborative Workshops/ Seminars
2. All programmes or activities implemented under the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon.
3. A Core Team has to be formulated before the implementation of the programmes mentioned under this MoU, and the document in this regard shall be part of this MoU. The Core Team shall have the Principals of both the Colleges as the General Convenors, one Vice Principal each from both FMNC and JNC as the Coordinators, Deans of Faculties, Librarians and a Senior Faculty each from FMNC and JNC as members.
4. The Core Team shall meet quarterly to streamline the processes.
5. Every activity should have a Nodal Institution (FMNC or JNC)
6. The Core Team will identify the nodal institution for coordinating events in tune with the plan documents prepared in advance.
7. Any financial requirement that may arise during the implementation will be borne by the Nodal Institution. The financial requirements may not exceed *100,000 rupees*.

Period of MOU:

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective on its signing by the representatives of both FMNC and JNC for a period of Five Years and is subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement.

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Settlement of Disputes:

1. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both parties.
2. In the event of any unforeseen incident during collaborative activities both the parties agree to negotiate a mutually acceptable solution.
3. Should any disagreement arise out of the application, interpretation or implementation of this agreement, the parties shall endeavor to exercise best efforts to settle their differences.

Termination:

This agreement may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by either party upon six months' prior notice to the other in writing.
