



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

GROUP CYBER ID TECHNOLOGY PVT. LTD.

This Memorandum of Understanding is made on **20 February 2023**.

BETWEEN

Jyoti Nivas College, an Autonomous college Institute for women, (hereinafter referred to as “**Jyoti Nivas**” or as “**Institute**”), located at Hosur Rd, 5th Block, Koramangala, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560095 represented by its principal Dr. Sr. Lalitha Thomas

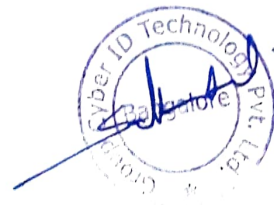
AND

Group Cyber ID Technology Pvt. Ltd. (hereinafter after called as “**GCID**”.) having its registered office at #24, 1st Floor, 1st Cross, Magrath Road, Ashok Nagar, Bangalore, Karnataka – 560025, represented by its CEO, Mr. Santosh Kumar,

Whereas this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called “**MOU**” sets out the understanding of the Parties’ intention to collaborate with each other.

1. Background:

- a. **Jyoti Nivas College** is a minority Christian College founded by the Sister’s of St. Joseph of Tarbes. It is affiliated to Bengaluru City University. Since its inception in 1966, Jyoti Nivas College has remained steadfast to one central commitment - to provide a balanced, comprehensive education in Arts, Science and Commerce, aimed at turning out intellectually enlightened, morally upright, spiritually oriented and socially committed young persons. It offers a range of undergraduate, postgraduate, and integrated programmes across the disciplines of Arts, Humanities, Sciences, Commerce and Management. Since 2014, it also offers B.Voc degree programmes (Banking and Finance, Visual Communication and Performing Arts) initiated by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt of India, and the University Grants Commission. The years of autonomy has ensured cutting edge curriculum that balances the conventional with the innovative and new as well as onus on value education, social outreach and community engagement.
- b. “**GCID**” is a private organization established in 2018 under section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013. GCID provides professional guidance and consultancy to institutes and organization to develop and implement a business process and quality management system that meets or exceeds internationally recognized standards and best practices in Homeland Security services, Crime Scene Investigation, Forensic Biology, Fingerprinting & Questioned Documents Analysis, Cyber Security, Digital Forensics, eDiscovery, and Cyber Defense.





2. Scope of the MoU:

This MoU formalizes the intent by both parties to collaborate and jointly undertake work as listed below.

- a. **Student internships and training:** GCID shall extend internships and training for deserving students pursuing UG programmes at the Institute from time to time based on a rigorous selection methodology. Students shall be governed by a contract and NDA to be signed between them and GCID.

GCID to provide customized and specialized training/workshop at the standard registration cost as per the requirements in the field of Forensic Science and allied subjects, Cyber Security, Digital Forensics, Crime investigation, and Homeland Security to Jyoti Nivas students as per their curriculum.

- b. **Faculty internships:** GCID shall offer industrial internships at its premises for faculty members if needed.
- c. **Collaborative Curriculum:** GCID and Jyoti Nivas shall co-create courses leveraging the expertise of Forensic Science and offer specific courses to students of Jyoti Nivas. Faculty members shall work in tandem with GCID employees and teach students over a combination of remote and in-person classes or training programs.

3. Duration & Termination

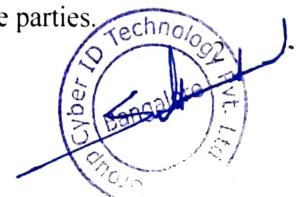
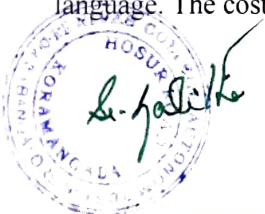
This agreement will become effective on the day of signature by the representatives of the respective parties till 20th February 2024. It is thereby mutually agreed to extend the Memorandum of Agreement and continue the partnership on an ongoing basis, with periodical review by both parties. This agreement is subject to revisions, renewal, or cancellation at any time by each of the parties and by mutual consent. Should either party wish to terminate the agreement, they must notify the other party in writing two months prior to the date of termination.

4. Limitation of Liability

In no event shall either Party be liable for, and either Party hereby waives the right to claim, any indirect, punitive, special, incidental, or consequential damages (including lost profits) directly or indirectly relating to or arising out of the breach of this Agreement, regardless of the form of action, whether in contract, tort, strict liability, or otherwise, and whether or not such damages were foreseen or unforeseen, even if either Party has been advised of the possibility thereof. Neither Party limits its liability (if any) to the other for: personal injury or death resulting from negligence; fraud; or any matter for which it would be illegal to exclude or attempt to exclude its liability.

5. Governing Law

This MOU shall be governed by applicable laws in India. Any dispute between the Parties, arising out of or in connection with this MOU or breach hereof, shall be resolved amicably between the authorized representatives of the Parties within a period of 30 (thirty) days, failing which such dispute shall be referred to sole arbitrator mutually nominated by both Parties. The venue of arbitration shall be Chennai, India, and the arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English language. The cost of Arbitration proceedings shall be borne equally by the parties.





6. Confidentiality

All information including any base and forward intellectual property shall be maintained by the parties in strict confidence and shall not be disclosed to any third party without prior express written permission from the disclosing party. However, the recipient of the confidential information may disclose, strictly on a need-to-know basis, proprietary Information to its personnel who engaged in the transaction contemplated herein who are in the process of accessing the confidential information of the disclosing part provided that such personnel are also bound by similar obligations of confidentiality to those contained herein. The confidentiality obligations herein contained shall continue to hold good during the tenure of the MoU, howsoever occasioned. The parties herein agree to execute a separate Non-Disclosure Agreement in connection with the exchange of confidential/proprietary information shared under this MoU.

7. Amendment

This MOU may be modified or amended if the amendment is mutually agreed and made in writing and is signed by authorized representatives of the Parties.

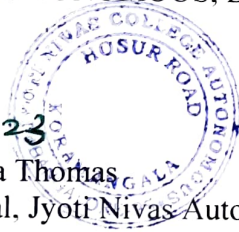

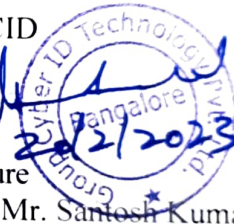
