AGREEMENT OF INTER-UNIVERSITY COOPERATION

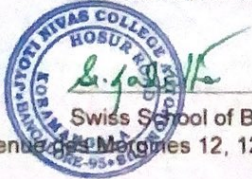
Article 1

This Agreement determines the areas and matters of mutual cooperation as well as the forms and manners of its implementation.

Article 2

Signatories of the Agreement will promote the academic cooperation through the following activities:

1. Exchange of staff:
 - a. Exchange of the academic staff – both Universities can choose their staff for participation in the exchange with an aim of studying or lecturing at the other University, on the reciprocal base.
 - b. Visiting academic staff – both Universities can call professors from the other University for giving lectures or consultations for a certain period.
 - c. Visiting researchers – both Universities can choose one or more of their employees for visiting the other University because of improving the study or research.
2. Exchange of students – both Universities can exchange students, either in undergraduate or graduate studies, in the appropriate fields of study.
3. Exchange of all publications published by both Universities and important for the development of scientific and educational activities.
4. Mutual library communication and exchange of books, periodicals and other information materials.



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5. Organizing and carrying out joint research projects and mutual exchange of information on research results.
6. Organizing and carrying out undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate studies.
7. Exchange of information and coordination of admission requirements for undergraduate and graduate studies.
8. Exchange of experiences and information on study programmes and working methods.
9. Mutual exchange of information on academic activities and planned University development.
10. Organizing and participating in scientific and professional conferences, symposia, meetings and other similar forms of education.
11. Cooperation of students and student organizations in the field of academic, cultural and sport activities.
12. Other areas of mutual interest.

Article 3

Conditions of cooperation for every individual activity based on this Agreement (Article 2) should be defined in writing through the Annex of this Agreement, adopted and signed by both Universities before the concrete activities begin.

Article 4

The inter-university cooperation based on this Agreement (Article 2) will be carried out on the principle of reciprocity.

Article 5

Both Universities consent to mutually inform each other about all the circumstances important for the realization of this Agreement. **CONFIDENTIALITY:** Each of the parties accepts and declares that every information from the other party is of confidential nature, is the exclusive property of the latter, and has been or will be disclosed to the former solely with the purpose of enabling the full accomplishment of the present Agreement. For this reason, every piece of information provided by one party to the other before signing this Agreement and/or during its performance must be kept confidential and therefore may not be disclosed to any third parties.

AUTONOMY: This agreement is a statement of intentions and does not involve, in any instance whatsoever, any financial obligations between the subscribing institutions.

Article 6



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All possible amendments and additions of this Agreement will be concluded in writing and annexed to this Agreement.

Article 7

This Agreement will be concluded for 3 years (36 months) as a period of duration. It can be prolonged if both Universities agree in writing.

Article 8

Each University may cancel this Agreement in writing.
The cancellation period is 6 (six) months.
The Agreement will cease to apply at the end of the cancellation period, providing that the started activities must be carried out.

Article 9


The Agreement will go into effect when signed by the legal representatives of both Universities.
