1. Parties

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into by and between the iConferences (Pvt) Ltd, whose address is 178/13/B6, Kelanimulla, Angoda, 10620, Colombo, Sri Lanka, and Jyoti Nivas College, Bangalore, India whose address is Jyoti Nivas College, Bangalore, India.

2. Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to establish the terms and conditions under which Jyoti Nivas College, Bangalore, India will act as the academic partner for the 3rd International Conference on Women 2024 is scheduled to be held on 23-24 August 2024, online and in person (hybrid), Bangalore, India.

3. Terms of MOU

This MOU is effective upon the 09th of January 2024 signed and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MOU and the governing bodies of the parties' respective countries shall remain in full force and effect for not longer than 10 months. This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon one month's written notice, which notice shall be delivered by hand or by certified mail to the address listed above.

4. Obligations of the Party/Parties

Jyoti Nivas College, Bangalore, India
hereinafter will be referred as “Academic Partner”.

1. Academic Partner will be given three complimentary registrations to attend the conference. If there are more than three members who are interested in taking part, they will be offered a 10% discount on the registration fee. (In-person participants from India will receive a special rate. The above-mentioned 10% discount will be applied to it.)
2. Opportunity to publish in conference proceedings and reputed journals at no cost for those who register for Women 2024 representing the Academic Partner.
3. Academic Partner has the right to nominate faculty members to the scientific committee and full paper reviewing committee (Conference editorial board) Nominated members must have a minimum qualification of PhD or teaching experience in post graduates.
4. Academic Partner will be given priority in the event of appointing Session chairs/Evaluation committee.
5. Academic Partner will be invited to deliver a welcome speech at the inauguration ceremony of the Women 2024 conference.
6. Academic Partner will be given an opportunity to promote related course details for conference participants during the conference.
7. Academic Partner will be recognized on the conference website and online/offline conference materials.

1. The academic partner logo will be published on the conference website and these logos will be used in promotional materials, both online and offline.
2. The academic partner needs to publish our conference details on the university website and all related social media of the university.
3. Academic partner needs to disseminate the conference information among their well-known international and local networks. (Promotional materials will be provided)
4. We expect you to suggest a few faculty members for reviewing abstracts and this includes the full paper review after the conference.
5. Academic partners will provide their maximum support to bring down participants from every part of their country, other than their institution.

5. General Provisions

A. Amendments

Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.

B. Severability

Should any portion of this MOU be judicially determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

C. Third Party Beneficiary Rights

The parties do not intend to create in any other individual or entity the status of a third-party beneficiary, and this MOU shall not be construed so as to create such a status. The rights, duties and obligations contained in this MOU shall operate only between the parties to this MOU and shall be ensured solely to the benefit of the parties to this MOU.

The provisions of this MOU are intended only to assist the parties in determining and performing their obligations under this MOU. The parties to this MOU intend and expressly agree that only party's signatory to this MOU shall have any legal or equitable right to seek to enforce this MOU, to seek any remedy arising out of a party's performance or failure to perform any term or condition of this MOU, or to bring an action for the breach of this MOU.

D. Confidentiality

The Parties including its officers, agents and authorized representatives shall not disclose, use or communicate to any person any confidential information of the other Party and not otherwise publicly available nor known by the recipient at the time of disclosure.




