The Centre for Media Studies (CMS) traces its origins to 1994, when it began as a program called Communicative English within the Department of English. Over the years, it evolved, and in 2015, it emerged as the Department of Communication. In 2019, it was officially renamed the Centre for Media Studies, solidifying its identity as a hub for media education and innovation. Now, CMS proudly celebrates 30 years of shaping media professionals, fostering creative thinking, and contributing to the ever-evolving media landscape.



We are also celebrating 30 years of the media studies here at Jyoti Nivas, which started in 1994. It was known as Communicative English back in the day. From those humble beginnings, it changed to communication in media and then evolved into the name that we know and love today, The Centre for Media Studies. Which has been a cornerstone in shaping the academic landscape, offering key programs in Communicative English, Journalism, and Visual Communications.

General Rules and Regulations



- Entry is strictly limited to participants with a valid college ID card.
- Registration fees are non-refundable for both individual participants and contingents.
- On-spot registrations are permitted but must be completed at least 90 minutes before the event begins.
- Participants must arrive at the event venue at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
- Any form of vulgarity or inappropriate conduct in speech, performance, music, or attire will result in immediate disqualification and deduction of points from the college's overall championship score.
- The judges' decisions are final and cannot be contested.
- Alcohol, drugs, or any intoxicating substances are strictly prohibited. Violation will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Refer to the Scoring Overview for details on your college's eligibility for the overall championship.

Terms and Conditions



- To qualify for the overall championship, colleges must register for the events listed below as a contingent.
- The contingent registration fee is ₹2500.
- Changes to the participant list for the contingent will not be accepted once registration closes.
- Each college can enter only one team or individual for each event under the contingent category. Any additional teams or individuals from the same college must register separately as individual participants, and their results will not count towards the overall score.
- The registration fee is non-refundable.
- Colleges traveling from out of town are responsible for arranging their own travel and accommodation.
