

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Entry without a current college ID card is prohibited.
- 2. Dress code must be strictly followed.
- 3. Registration Fee is Non-Refundable for both individual and contingent
- 4. On-spot registration is allowed but the registrations should be made 90 minutes prior to the event.
- 5. Participants are required to report 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the event.
- 6. Vulgarity or misconduct of any sort either in speech, performance, music or costume will lead to immediate disqualification and deduction of college points for overall championship.
- 7. The judges' decision for all events will be final and binding
- 8. No form of arguments will be entertained from the participants regarding the same.
- 9. PleaserefertotheScoringOverviewtounderstand your college's eligibility to compete for the overall championship

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

- 1. The possession, use, sale, or distribution of illicit substances on college premises is strictly prohibited.
- 2. Illicit substances include alcohol, cigarettes, vapes, illegal drugs, controlled substances, unauthorized prescription medications.
- 3. Possession of drug paraphernalia, including items used for the consumption or distribution of illicit substances, is strictly forbidden.
- 4. Possession of prescription medications without a valid prescription is prohibited.
- 5. No person under the influence of illicit substances will be allowed to participate in or attend the fest.
- 6. No sanitizer and lighters are permitted
- 7. No makeup/ skincare/ cosmetics will be allowed on the premises.
- 8. Prohibited items and substances if found will be confiscated and will not be returned under any circumstances

GRITERIA FOR OVERALL GHAMPIONSHIP

Rules

- Colleges must register for the below events under bulk to be considered for the overalls.
 - The contingent registration fee of Rs.7000/-
- Changes to the participant list for the contingent, once registration closes, will not be entertained.
- Only one team or individual per college can participate in an event as a contingent. Any other team or individual from the same college will have to register themselves under individual registration and the winner of this team or individual will not be considered for overalls.
 - Registration fee is non-refundable
- Those colleges attending from out of station will have to make their own arrangements for travel and accommodation.








- . Participants per team: 5-8 members

- . Time limit: 2+2 minutes GASH PRIZE: ₹9,000






- . Individual Event

- . Participants should assemble in front of the Jyoti Auditorium






- . Individual Event

- . Time limit: 15 minutes





- . Time Limit: 8 Minutes + 2 Minutes for setup GASH PRIZE: ₹5,000








- . Individual Event

- . Time Limit: 2 hour






- No. of participants per college is 5 to 8

- . Unions must remain civil before and after the event







- . Time limit: 4+1 minutes






- . Participants in a team: 2 members

- . Time limit: 3+1 minutes






- . Participants per team: 3-10 members

- . Time limit: 5+1 minutes






- . Participants per team: 5 members.

- . Time limit: 4+1 minutes GASH Prize: ₹2,500






