- Exceeding the time limit may result in point deductions
- Research Presentations must be brought on a pen drive and tested in advance to ensure compatibility with Microsoft PowerPoint or PDF format
- Evaluations will be based on clarity, relevance, originality and adherence to time

#### **GUIDELINES FOR POSTER DISPLAY**

- Infographic posters must align with the theme:
   'Connections and Communities in the Digital World'
- Keep content concise and visually engaging
- Use colours, typography and layouts effectively. Ensure originality and proper credits
- Online submission is required by 26th February. Printed posters must be submitted at the venue on 3rd March by 9:30 a.m for display
- Only printed posters are allowed; handmade submissions will not be accepted
- Posters will be evaluated based on relevance, clarity, creativity, visual appeal and originality
