Theory truly met the trading floor on February 20, 2026, 23 students from the M.Com (FA) program at Jyoti Nivas College PG Centre conducted an industrial visit to Bangalore Stock Exchange Financials Limited. This excursion, integrated into the academic curriculum, aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical finance and practical capital market operations.

The delegation departed campus at 9:00 AM, with the formal workshop commencing at 10:30 AM. The session focused extensively on Portfolio Diversification, Mergers & Acquisitions (M&A), and career mapping within the financial sector. Beyond the lecture, students participated in a guided tour and a mock trading simulation, providing a rare "behind-the-scenes" look at real-time market mechanics. This experiential learning opportunity allowed students to explore advanced certification platforms, effectively extending their financial literacy beyond the standard textbook framework.

Workshop Highlights

a) Introduction to Stock Market Operations

The session began with an explanation of:

- Role and structure of stock exchanges
- Primary and secondary markets
- Buying and selling of equity shares
- Factors influencing stock prices

b) Mock Trading Worksheet

Students were given a **mock trading worksheet** simulating real market conditions. We were required to:

- Analyse share price movements
- Make decisions to buy, sell, or hold stocks
- Calculate profit or loss

The simulated activity included companies such as:

- HAL
- Tech Mahindra
- Vedanta
- Infosys
- Reliance Industries

This exercise enhanced our understanding of practical market decision-making.

c) Portfolio Diversification

The resource person explained:

- Risk-return relationship
- Importance of diversification across sectors
- Building a balanced portfolio

Students learned how spreading investments reduces financial risk.

d) Mergers & Acquisitions (M&A)

The concept of mergers and acquisitions was introduced, highlighting:

- Corporate restructuring strategies
- Impact of M&A announcements on share prices
- Investor reaction and market volatility

e) Interactive Q&A Session

A fun and engaging question-answer round was conducted, encouraging active participation and reinforcing learning.

From a managerial perspective, the visit emphasized:

- Strategic financial decision-making

- Risk evaluation and mitigation
- Analytical thinking in uncertain environments
- Importance of diversification in investment planning
- Understanding market psychology and investor behaviour
