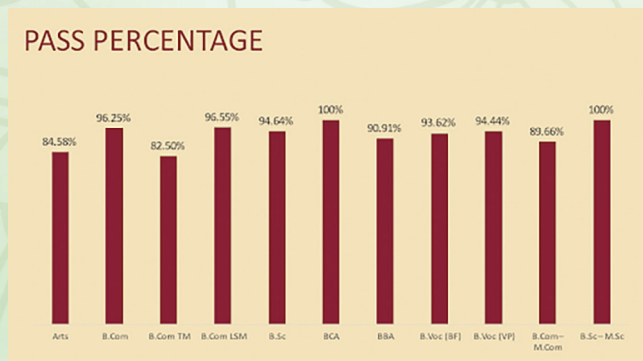

We have a total of 114 faculty teaching our various undergraduate courses among whom 41 have completed PhD and 25 are currently pursuing their PhD. Of the 114 faculty, 52 belong to the 12 departments of humanities and languages, 38 belong to the Departments of Physical and Life Sciences and 23 belong to the Department of Commerce and Management.

I now present the results of the end-semester examination for the academic year 2022-2023. Among

the students who attended the examination, pass rates ranged from 82.50% to 100%. Notably, a 100% pass rate was observed in both the Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) programme and the integrated BSc-Msc programme.



Jyoti Nivas College Autonomous, has an active placement cell dedicated to providing training and job opportunities for its students. Remarkably, among those who registered with the placement cell, an impressive 89% have successfully secured placements. The top placements of the academic year were Sanika S. Lad, (BCA), Sahana P., (B.Com), and Swarangi Raverkar (B.Com BL).

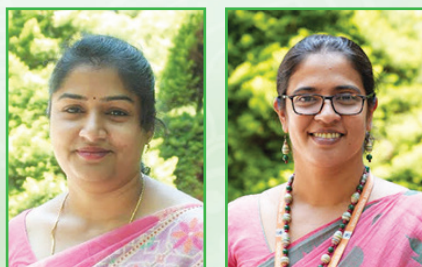

Ms. Vanhmingliani Hnamte, Assistant Professor from the Department of Psychology, has been elected as the Secretary of the Bangalore Mizo Association.

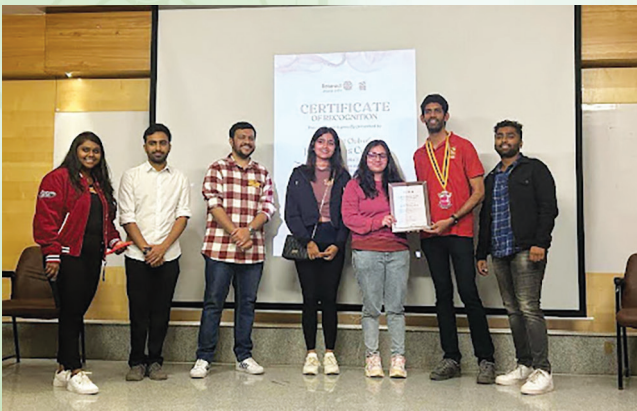

The National Cadet Corps of Jyoti Nivas College has consistently won several awards over the past several years. This year, they conducted 11 activities in addition to their weekly parades.
